

The NitFree Terminator Comb is the ultimate tool to fight head lice and their eggs. Did you know that a **single** louse lays four to five nits at a time, **twice** a day? COMPARISON COMB STUDY OF THE THREE LEADING COMBS CURRENTLY ON THE US MARKET

Conducted May, 2007

The objective of the study was to show that combs make a difference when treating active cases of head lice and that the choice of the comb did matter. To achieve this goal Genesis Products requested that Lice Solutions combed one hundred subjects a total of forty strokes. Twenty strokes would

be administered to one side of the head with the Terminator Comb and either the LiceMeister or the Rid Comb (based on previously selected randomization process) be used to comb twenty strokes on the opposite side of the head.



The Results

There was no doubt that there was a noticeable difference in the comb used. While all three combs proved relatively effective in helping to remove the adult lice (thus still a viable resource for identification purposes) there was however an obvious difference in the amount of nits removed. The Terminator removed on average 200 nits compared to the LiceMeister's 90 nits, and the Terminator/Rid comparison shows the Terminator removed 128 nits to The Rid Comb's 38 nits.
